## CMAC Sep 2021 COVID Safe Access Plan

As of 15<sup>th</sup> October, the ACT Government <u>advises</u> up to 25 people can engage in socially distanced outdoor recreation activities, with some rules. For CMAC, this means we can undertake *most* flying activities from Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> October. In order to keep club members safe, and protect our collective reputation, here are the simplified rules that we still need to adhere to:

- Absolutely no more than 25 people at the field at one time:
  - o We will not run a booking system, but please use common sense.
  - Please only visit if you are flying or directly assisting somebody to do so (ie instruction).
  - If you arrive and there are already 25 folks, please do not stay and exceed the limit.
  - Please leave promptly when you have finished flying.
  - Please try and prioritise the weekend flying opportunities for those working weekdays.
- Please use the ACT Government <u>check in application</u> at the club the QR code sign in the notice board or you can use the recent activity feature in the app to sign back in. Please also assist any other members if they don't have a mobile - check them in on your phone as a guest.
- Please wear a mask while at the club
- Please remain socially distanced while at the club, use common sense in the pilot box especially and keep up the verbal coordination.
- Clubhouse will be limited to a maximum of 6 people at one time, please do not light the fire or use the kitchen facilities bring your own drinks.
- Wash your hands after using bathroom (seriously).
